Northern District of Indiana

Standard Conditions of Supervision

- 1. The individual under supervision shall not leave the judicial district without the permission of the court or probation officer.
- 2. The individual under supervision shall report to the probation officer in a manner and frequency directed by the court or probation officer.
- 3. The individual under supervision shall answer truthfully all inquiries by the probation officer and follow the instructions of the probation officer.
- 4. The individual under supervision shall support his or her dependents and meet other family responsibilities.
- 5. The individual under supervision shall work regularly at a lawful occupation unless excused by the probation officer for schooling, training, or other acceptable reasons.
- 6. The individual under supervision shall notify the probation officer at least ten days prior to any change in residence or employment.
- 7. The individual under supervision shall refrain from excessive use of alcohol and shall not purchase, possess, use, distribute, or administer any controlled substance or any paraphernalia related to any controlled substance, except as prescribed by a physician.
- 8. The individual under supervision shall not frequent places where controlled substances are illegally sold, used, distributed, or administered.
- 9. The individual under supervision shall not associate with any persons engaged in criminal activity and shall not associate with any person convicted of a felony, unless granted permission to do so by the probation officer.
- 10. The individual under supervision shall permit a probation officer to visit him or her at any time at home or elsewhere and shall permit confiscation of any contraband observed in plain view of the probation officer.
- 11. The individual under supervision shall notify the probation officer within 72 hours of being arrested or questioned by a law enforcement officer.
- 12. The individual under supervision shall not enter into any agreement to act as an informer or a special agent of a law enforcement agency without the permission of the court.
- 13. As directed by the probation officer, the individual under supervision shall notify third parties of risks due to the individual's criminal record or personal history or characteristics and shall permit the probation officer to make such notifications and to the individual under supervision's compliance with such notification requirement.

Travel Restrictions

The Northern District of Indiana is comprised of 32 counties. You are allowed to travel freely within these counties. Unless you are given permission in advance by the judge in your case, any requests to travel outside of these 32 counties must be approved in advance by your U.S. Probation Officer.

- 1. Failure to obtain advance approval may result in a violation of your supervision.
- 2. Only the court may approve travel outside of the contiguous United States.
